


## Prohibited signs on *private property*

### Miscellaneous Signs and Posters

The tacking, pasting, or otherwise affixing of signs of a miscellaneous character, visible from a public way, located on walls of buildings, barns, sheds, trees, poles, posts, fences or other structures is prohibited.

### Parking of Advertising Vehicles

No person shall park any vehicle or trailer on a public right-of-way, or public property, or on private property so as to be visible from a public right-of-way, which has attached thereto or located thereon, any sign or advertising device for the basic purpose of providing advertisement of products or directing people to a business or activity located on the same premises or any other premises. This is not intended to prohibit any form of vehicular signage such as a sign attached to a bus or lettering on a motor vehicle.



## Prohibited Signs on *public property*

No person shall nail, paste, paint, or otherwise affix in any manner any lithograph, sign, advertisement, picture, or design whatever upon any bridge, viaduct, sidewalk, parking, parkway, boulevard, crosswalk, curb, or street or upon the railings or approaches of any bridge, viaduct, or sidewalk or upon any telephone, telegraph, electrical light, or fire alarm pole or post.


## Allowable temporary signs

Portable signs up to 32 square feet in size may be displayed in commercial, industrial, institutional, and office zoning districts for a total of 60 days per calendar year at any one business location.


Permits may be issued for terms of either **15** or **30** days. Subsequent permits shall not be issued until **30** days have elapsed following the expiration of a **15**-day permit and **60** days following a **30**-day permit. Permits for two or more signs may be issued at a particular business location if the permits are of equal duration and run concurrently.

Portable signs must be secured against overturning and cannot be placed on or over public right-of-way or within intersection and driveway safety zones. (See diagram.)
