

PACKAGE MALT BEVERAGE/SD FARM WINERY -- NEW

<u>EXPLANATION</u>	An applicant wishing to sell package malt beverage must obtain a Package Malt Beverage License. This license can be used for selling any product that has a malt base, including malt-based wine coolers. In addition, you may sell South Dakota farm winery wines; no other type of wine can be sold.
<u>FEE</u>	\$255 which includes publication and fire inspection fees.
<u>SCHEDULING</u>	From the time of receipt of application until City Council action is taken is approximately four to six weeks.
<u>HOURS</u>	7 a.m. to 2 a.m., Monday through Sunday.
<u>TERM</u>	The Package Malt Beverage/SD Farm Winery License runs from July 1 through June 30 of any given year and renewed each May.
<u>RESTRICTIONS</u>	Any clerk dispensing the alcoholic beverages must be 21 years of age.
<u>CHECKLIST/ CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT</u>	The first step for the applicant will be to complete page 1 of the Alcohol License Application Checklist. This checklist is then routed to the City Zoning Office (605-367-8254) followed by the City Planning Office (605-367-8888). If it is determined that a Conditional Use Permit is required for the proposed location, this process must take place prior to license application.
