Featured Parks

BRYANT PARK

1400 East 34th Street

Shoot some hoops and go for a slide at this northeastern park.

BURNSIDE PARK

1500 West Burnside Street

Located near the convention center, you can catch a ball game and go for a swing.

DUNHAM PARK

1301 South Marion Road

Easy bike trail access, lots of ball fields and parking, volleyball, and a playground make this park a treasure on Skunk Creek.

ELMWOOD PARK

1401 North Kiwanis Avenue

This park is host to many ball fields, a volleyball court, playground with swings, and paved bike trail access.

LEGACY PARK

7001 West 12th Street

Head northwest from Dunham Park on the trail to find this park's nature area and fishing accesses.

EARL MCCART FIELDS

2001 West Madison Avenue

League softball fields, a great playground, and paved walking paths can be found at this park near the Denny Sanford Premier Center.

PASLEY PARK

2521 South Southeastern Avenue
