General

For the Electrical Contractor and Class B examinations, applications cannot be accepted unless the applicant holds an equivalent South Dakota state license. Applications that are incomplete or not accompanied with the fee will not be processed. Applications must be received one week prior to the next scheduled testing date to qualify for testing on that date.

Application

This form must be legible and fully completed, signed, and dated by the applicant.

Fee—\$75

The fee is nonrefundable. Make check or money order payable to the City of Sioux Falls.

Examination Schedule

First Wednesday of each month at 8 a.m. Please notify our office if you are unavailable for the exam date.

Examination Location

224 West Ninth Street, Old City Council Chambers, First Floor.

Examination

Electrical Contractor—The examination consists of open and closed book sections with multiple choice, fill in the blank, and calculation questions. The permitted test time is four hours. It is advisable to bring a calculator.

Sign Wiring Contractor—The examination is open book and consists of fill in the blank questions. The permitted test time is two hours. It is advisable to bring a calculator.

Fire Alarm Contractor—The examination is open book and consists of multiple choice questions. The permitted test time is two hours. It is advisable to bring a calculator.

Please bring two pencils or pens. Scratch paper will be provided. No cell phones are allowed.

Study Suggestions

For electrical and Class B contractors, the Electrical Board of Appeals and Examiners suggests that you study the City Electrical Ordinances Chapter 15 and the 2008 National Electrical Code. For sign wiring contractor, they suggest studying Article 600, National Electrical Code. For fire alarm contractors, they suggest studying Article 760 of the 2008 National Electrical Code and the 2007 National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Standard 72, *National Fire Alarm Code*.

License

You must apply for your license within 90 days after passing the examination or you will be required to retest.

Parking

One hour free parking is provided on the Ninth Street and Dakota Avenue sides of City Hall. Please remember this is one (1) hour parking only and the permitted test time is three (3) hours.

There are meters along Ninth Street between Dakota Avenue and Minnesota Avenue. The cost at these meters is 40 cents per hour. You are able to put in money for up to ten (10) hours at one time in these meters.

There are also 10-hour meters available at the parking lot at 231 North Dakota Avenue. This lot is 1 1/2 blocks north of City Hall on the west side of Dakota Avenue, just north of the parking ramp and across the street from the library.

Please be sure not to park in any parking ramps without previously receiving permission.
