- (3) acting in an advisory capacity to the City Commission concerning transit and paratransit system performance, financial status, establishment and/or revisions of transit and paratransit service elements (such as routes, fares, schedules, days/hours of operation, marketing programs, etc.) and actions having a significant financial impact on the bus system;
- (4) disseminating information to the public on planned transit and paratransit improvements; and
- (5) reviewing applications of private non-profit organizations in the Sioux Falls area for the purchase of federally financed vehicles to determine whether any conflict may exist with public bus transportation and paratransit services; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS, SOUTH DAKOTA, that a Public Transit Advisory Board to advise and assist the City Commission in the review and implementation of public (bus) transportation and paratransit improvements is hereby

established, and the Mayor is authorized, with the approval of the City Commission, to appoint seven (7) citizens from this community to serve various lengths of terms on said board.
