Subject: Mandatory Recycling Requirements for Sioux Falls Residents

In an effort to extend the life of the Sioux Falls Regional Sanitary Landfill, the City of Sioux Falls has **mandatory recycling requirements** for waste haulers and Sioux Falls residents.

The recycling requirements asked of licensed waste haulers and Sioux Falls residents is outlined in Chapter 57 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sioux Falls, SD.

Per Section 57.027, recyclable materials shall be separated from household garbage and rubbish. Required recyclables collected shall not be deposited in the sanitary landfill. Required recyclables include paper products, corrugated cardboard and chip board, plastic bottles, tubs, and jugs, and metal containers such as aluminum and tin cans. Under Section 57.032, waste haulers shall not collect solid waste containing visible required recyclable materials for disposal as long as the waste hauler leaves a note explaining why the solid waste was not collected. Residents must remove the required recyclables before the hauler can collect the solid waste that has been rejected for this reason.

For your reference, a recycling guide has been included with this letter. The green side includes materials which may be accepted in your single-stream recycling container, and the red side shows items which should not be placed in your single-stream recycling bin. We thank you for your efforts to increase recycling and waste diversion in our community. By making the effort to recycle, you are helping to protect our local landfill, help our local solid waste and recycling economy, and conserve precious natural resources.
