

SCOPE

The City of Sioux Falls participates in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). NFIP is a cooperative effort between the City of Sioux Falls and FEMA. A flood development application and permit is required for any development on properties within the Special Flood Hazard area as indicated on the Digital Flood Insurance Rate Map. Permits are required to ensure that the proposed project meets the requirements of the NFIP and the City of Sioux Falls Floodplain Management Ordinance. Development means any manmade changes to improved or unimproved real estate. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Construction of new structures
- Modifications or improvements to existing structures
- Excavation
- Filling
- Paving
- Drilling
- Driving of piles
- Mining
- Dredging
- Land clearing
- Grading
- Permanent storage of materials and/or equipment

OTHER PERMITS

It is the responsibility of the applicant to obtain all other necessary federal, state, and local permits (i.e., "404" Dredge and Fill permit, etc.)
