RFP 15-0065 Private Development Downtown with a Public Parking Structure

Question: Within the RFP document, page 6 it states that the proposal must supply a minimum of 300 net public spaces, Is this 300 instead of the 500 net spaces that were discussed in the preliminary meeting?

Answer: The Walker Parking Study recommended the need for 500 net parking spaces over the next 2-5 years. Proposals must supply a minimum of 300 net public parking spaces to be accepted, however, net public parking spaces gained is allotted 15 maximum points for technical evaluation purposes.
