

**Answers to Questions Received as of July 21, 2015.**

**RFP 15-0118 Enterprise Asset Management Consultant Services**

1. What is the plan for the new Fleet Management software you are considering from Mercury Associates?
  - a. Many EAM applications have an add-on module to manage the specific requirements of Transportation and Fleet Vehicles.

**Answer: It is not expected the fleet management software would be an EAMS add on module but rather a separate best of breed fleet management software system procured with the assistance of Mercury Associates.**

2. Do you want RFP samples that we could present to the City included with the response?
  - a. Your request of brevity was understood and this will expand the response i.e.: pages, quite extensively.

**Answer: Proposals need to follow the submittal requirements in section 3.01 and proposers will be reviewed and selected based on section 4. How a firm chooses to meet the requirements of these sections is at their discretion.**

3. Public Parking is noted as one of the departments.
  - a. What features and functionality would you need to satisfy their requirements?

**Answer: Public parking is responsible for maintenance and operation of several parking ramps and surface lots. It is anticipated they could utilize an EAMS to manage these physical assets from a maintenance, work order, and lifecycle standpoint but the City is willing to listen to other opportunities an EAMS system can provide.**
