RESOLUTION NO. 22-05

WHEREAS, the SculptureWalk Program of the Sioux Empire Arts Council will bring a large number of sculptures to the central business district for outdoor display;

WHEREAS, 48 of the proposed sculptures will be placed on public right-of-way or other publicly-owned property;

WHEREAS, the exhibition of public art in the central business district is recommended and encouraged by the final report of the Downtown Art Committee (DART), the City of Sioux Falls' 2015 Downtown Plan, and the Sioux Empire Arts Council's Sioux Empire Cultural Plan;

WHEREAS, the SculptureWalk Program represents a broad collaboration of individuals and entities, both public and private, including Main Street Sioux Falls, the Sioux Empire Arts Council, the Chamber of Commerce, and the City of Sioux Falls; and

WHEREAS, the Sioux Falls Visual Arts Commission has reviewed the proposed sculptures and their placements, and has recommended the proposed placements be approved by the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS, SD:

That it approves the placement in public right-of-way, on public and private property of 48 sculptures, as described by the following:

“Orin-3”—SW corner of 11th St. and Main Ave. at the Washington Pavilion.

“Wild Bill Hickok”—In front of Home Federal Bank at the corner of 11th St. and Main Ave. (Private Property)

“Natural Instinct”—In front of the Great Outdoor Store at corner of 11th St. and Phillips Ave.

“Celtic Dog”—In front of The Book Shop on Phillips Ave.

“After Knights Meal Cigar”—In front of Mrs. Murphy's Irish Gifts on Phillips Ave.

“Buffalo Robe”—In front of Prairie Star Gallery on Phillips Ave.

“Living Storm”—SW corner of Tenth St. and Phillips Ave.

“The Bather”—On west side of the steps in Fountain Plaza.

“Oak Leaf”—In front of CNA on Phillips Ave.

“Blue Moon II”—In front of Wells Fargo Bank at corner of Ninth St. and Phillips Ave. (Private Property)

“High Tailing It”—In front of Wells Fargo Bank on Ninth St., between Main Ave. and Phillips Ave.

“Summer Storm”—In front of Wells Fargo Bank between Main Ave. and Phillips Ave.

“The Great Escape”—On Eighth St., in front of the Holiday Inn City Centre, west of “Tool Shed.”

“Tool Shed”—On Eighth St., in front of Holiday Inn City Centre.

“Warrior”—In tree planter between Holiday Inn City Centre driveways, along Phillips Ave.

“From Death, Comes Life”—SE corner of Eighth St. and Phillips Ave.

“Wings”—In front of Brewery Building on SW corner of Fifth St. and Phillips Ave.

“Amillary”—West side of the former Raven’s Training Center at Sixth St. and Phillips Ave.

“Seed”—SE corner of Sixth St. and Phillips Ave.

“Baby Jack”—In front of renovated Van Brunt Building on Phillips Ave.

“If Wishes Take Root”—In front of renovated Crane Bldg. on Eighth St. (Private Property)

“Seated Couple”—In front of Craftsman Creek Studio & Gallery on Eighth St. (Private Property)

“Outcropping House”—At corner of Eighth St. and Reid Ave., near 8th & Railroad Center (Private Property)

“Buffalo”—East of Eighth St. bridge on the south side.

“Two Eagles”—In Security Bank planter at Ninth St. and Phillips Ave. (Private Property)

“Sovereign Son”—In front of First National Bank on Phillips Ave.

“Buffalo Warrior”—In front of John Adam’s store on Phillips Ave.

“Otherworld Journey”—In front of John Adam’s store on Phillips Ave.

“The Stand”—In landscaping on Tenth St., just west of Great Western Bank.

“Prairie Gathering”—On grass island at Tenth St. and Second Ave.

“Means to an End”—On grass near river at Tenth St. and Second Ave.

“The Shepherd”—On SE corner of Tenth St. and Phillips Ave.

“Rachel Weeping”—In front of Suzanne’s on Phillips Ave.

“Raven Augury”—Hanging from branches and on ground in front of AAA Travel in Shriver’s Square.

“1864”—On corner of 11th St. and Phillips Ave. in front of Shriver’s Square on Phillips Ave.

“Dakota Sun”—On 11th St. in front of Clock Tower Parking Ramp.

“Pattern”—On corner of 11th St. and Phillips Ave. in front of Dacotah Bank.

“Clair de lune”—In front of Dacotah Bank on Phillips Ave.

“Buster”—In front of Coffee-n-Clay on Phillips Ave.

“Hour Smile”—In front of KELO Radio on Phillips Ave.

“Sonrise”—In front of KELO TV on Phillips Ave.

“Cameron’s Dragon”—On corner of 13th St. and Phillips Ave. south of Sushi Masa Restaurant

“R. F. Pettigrew”—Near Bechtold Jewelers on Phillips Ave. in front of Seeman Building.

“Knocking on Spencer’s Door”—Near Bechtold Jewelers on Phillips Ave. in front of Seeman Building.

“Fighting Stallions”—In front of Paramount Studio on Phillips Ave.

“Youth Sculpture”—Falls Park, near Horse Barn.

“Soul of the Musician”—In front of Orpheum Theater on Phillips Ave.

“Our World”—NE corner of Ninth St. and Dakota Ave. at City Hall.
