**MEETING MINUTES**

**ITEM 1. (1:01) Call to Order and Quorum Determination** The meeting was called to order at 9:01 am by Chairperson James Zajicek.

**ITEM 3. Approval of Regular Agenda (1:20)**

Commissioner Schaeffer made a motion to approve the regular agenda, Commissioner Lum seconded the motion. The agenda was unanimously approved.

**ITEM 4. Approval of Minutes from April 20, 2021 Regular Meeting and April 27, 2021 Working Session (1:55)**

A motion was made by Commissioner Lum to approve the April 20 meeting minutes and the motion was seconded by Commissioner Schaeffer. The minutes were unanimously approved.

**ITEM 6. Unfinished Business (3:03)**

- a) **Mural Registration Application:** Available through CSS (customer self service) online, Visual Arts Commission and Planning webpages.  
Commissioner Lum asked if there will be public awareness about the new mural ordinance. Diane reported that the department will have a news release about it. Commissioner Boice offered to have the news release available to the Arts Council. Commissioner Zajicek also asked if the city will be producing a brochure for the application and registration.
- b) **Placement of *Sea Dream* sculpture: (7:54)** Diane provided a brief update regarding the review of the sculpture and review with Mike Patten and artist Steve Thomas when he comes to Sioux Falls. Commissioner Zajicek noted that in our working session on April 27, Jeff Eckhoff having an informal meeting with Park Board and VAC board to have a discussion about placement of the sculpture. Commissioner Boice commented that the VAC was asked their recommendation on where to place the sculpture and with new opportunities like Park West, VAC would like to open up communication with Parks for future discussions.

**ITEM 7. New Business (14:18)**

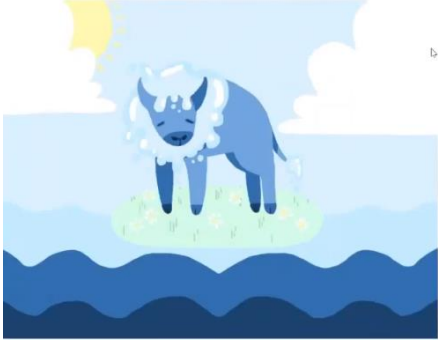
a) **Jury for Storm Inlet Drain Artwork Submittals**
