## PUBLIC NOTICE

This notice provides the public an opportunity to examine and comment on amendment #1 to the 2020 Annual Action Plan for the City of Sioux Falls for a period of 30 days. Low- and moderate-income persons, racial and ethnic minorities, non-English speaking persons, and persons with disabilities are specifically encouraged to review and comment on the proposed amendment. The Action Plan is part of the City's Consolidated Plan. It identifies specific activities to be undertaken with the use of federal funding from both the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program and Home Investment Partnerships (HOME) program. Anyone wishing to comment on the proposed amendment should do so in writing and send the same to the Housing Division, PO Box 7402, Sioux Falls, SD, 57117-7402. Written comments must include the name and address of the individual submitting the comment. The comment period ends at 5 p.m. on December 7, 2022.

Up to \$1,337,244 of CDBG-CV (COVID-19 response) funds will be provided to Inter-Lakes Community Action Partnership, Inc. (ICAP) for the acquisition and rehabilitation for the Children's Inn property in Sioux Falls, SD. Specifically, these funds will be used toward purchasing a portion of the non-congregate shelter, the Weatherization offices/warehouse, and a portion of the ICAP Housing staff's office space. The proposed Non-Congregate Shelter portion of the Children's Inn consumes approximately 70% of the entire building. ICAP's acquisition request for CDBG-CV funding is approximately 43% of the current building with the remainder of the request to be used for rehabilitation of the building. This project is contingent upon Accessible Housing Advisory Board (AHAB) approval.

Funding for the new allocation listed above is obtained from CDBG-CV funding provided to the City of Sioux Falls to "prevent, prepare for, and respond to the spread of COVID-19."
