



YEAR-ROUND LAWN WATERING SCHEDULE



In an effort to promote the wise use of water, better manage our water infrastructure and resources, and extend the lifespan of our existing water supply, the City of Sioux Falls has implemented a schedule of year-round lawn watering restrictions as follows:

- ◆ **No daily lawn watering between 12 noon and 5 p.m. for anyone.**
- ◆ **The lawn watering schedule is subject to change if weather conditions warrant.**
- ◆ **Customers having EVEN-numbered addresses may only water on EVEN-numbered calendar dates. Customers having ODD-numbered addresses may only water on ODD-numbered calendar dates.**

Example: If your house number ends in a 1, 3, 5, 7, or 9, you may water your lawn on any odd day of the month, such as the 1st, 3rd, 5th (and so on) of each month. If your house number ends in a 0, 2, 4, 6, or 8, you may water your lawn on any even day of the month, such as the 2nd, 4th, 6th (and so on) of each month.

Important Water Rate Information: Sioux Falls Utilities employs increasing block rates to encourage water conservation. This means the per unit charge increases as the amount of water used increases. Conservation rates can have a significant impact on your utility bill when irrigating your lawn or installing a new lawn.
