High Priority

1. Sidewalks and curb cuts should be cleared of all snow within 48 hours as required by City ordinance [Sec. 96-100 Duty to Remove Snow].

The entire connection should be clear, including the ramps and gutters, there is an understanding of the public ROW snow removal impacting these connections, but for the traveling public all needs to be cleared in order to have safe travel.

We need to have enforcement, and proactive maintenance.
